How to use this guidance

This guidance is addressed to data controllers, i.e. the organisation, business or public authority that controls how the personal data is used. Separate guidance specifically for individuals (data subjects) may be found <u>here</u>.

This guidance aims to explain how the Office of the Ombudsman will likely interpret certain provisions of the DPA, and is not binding.

- <u>Relevant provisions</u>: states the relevant sections of the Data Protection Act.
